FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When does my current membership expire?

The Annual Membership Drive is November and December. Membership deadline is January 15. Memberships received other times during the year will not be pro-rated.

When will I receive my membership card?

You should receive your membership card by mail each January.

How can I use my membership card?

Your membership card provides you with discounted ticket prices to all events and free admission to Artist Receptions held at the Art Center.

How are my membership dollars spent?

Your membership supports the Art Center's annual fund. The annual fund directly supports everything we do at the Art Center such as: donations to the art departments of schools in Humboldt County, scholarships to graduating seniors in Humboldt County, free community events like the Art Festival in the park, supplements class instructor fees and provides free admission and refreshments to some events.

What annual activities does the Art Council provide?

Annually, we have a Community Photography Display, a Wine Tasting as the kick off to the Art Festival which is held annually in June at John Brown Park. We also have two community theatre productions; a Mystery Dinner Theatre in February and a Community Theatre Production in the summer. Each year we pick a theme and have a community art exhibit and reception with the items donated to our silent and live auction held in October. This is our annual fundraiser, The Art Encore, with live entertainment, edible art and auction.

Will I receive written acknowledgement of my membership for tax purposes?

All members will receive an acknowledgement and thank you postcard with your membership card mailed in January. This will serve as written acknowledgement of your charitable contribution and should be kept with your records. The Art Council does not provide any additional written acknowledgement of your charitable contribution at the end of year or prior to tax filing deadlines.
